The Tech Model Railroad Club at MIT

Just as Disney's Railroad and Monorail spoke moral agendas to the world, the TRMC railroad also spoke in anticipatory transposition. There was a real world visible to viewers, faithfully represented in historical detail, and below there was an abstract world of electronic control— The System literally and metaphorically underneath the baseboard. The process of The System's evolution was via a series of innovations called "hacks." The Signals and Power people called themselves "hackers."

HACK:... an unconventional or unorthodox application of technology.

HACKER: one who hacks, or makes them. A hacker avoids the standard solution. The hack is the basic concept; the hacker is defined in terms of it.



The Hacker Manifesto

"This is our world now... the world of the electron and the switch, the beauty of the baud. We make use of a service already existing without paying for what could be dirt-cheap if it wasn't run by profiteering gluttons, and you call us criminals. We explore... and you call us criminals. We seek after knowledge... and you call us criminals... You build atomic bombs, you wage wars, you murder, cheat, and lie to us and try to make us believe it's for our own good, yet we're the criminals...

"Yes, I am a criminal. My crime is that of curiosity... My crime is that of outsmarting you...

"I am a hacker, and this is my manifesto. You may stop this individual, but you can't stop us all."


